


The SCP Framework


- § Hazard reduction/elimination
- § not Risk Management

- OSHA
- EPA TSCA Work Plan Risk Assessments
- Superfund








What's covered

Sensitive Subpopulations

- Infants and children
- Pregnant women
- Elderly
- Vulnerable populations
- Increase exposure populations (workers)

What's not covered

- Pesticides
- Food
- Prescription drugs
- Medical packaging

- Natural toxins

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
2. Picking Products: Key Prioritization Principles

§ Potential exposure to the Candidate Chemicals in the product

AND

§ Potential for exposures to contribute to or cause significant or widespread adverse impacts





3. Alternatives Analysis

Answers key questions

- Is it necessary?
- Is there a safer alternative?
- Have regrettable substitutes been avoided?

4. Possible Regulatory Responses

- § No response
- § Additional information to DTSC
- § Additional information to consumers
- § Additional safety measures
- § Restrictions/Prohibitions on sales
- § End-of-life product stewardship
- § Research funding

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
Initial Priority Products

Announced March 2014

- 1. Children's Foam-padded Sleeping Products containing TDCPP and TCEP
- 2. Paint Strippers containing Methylene Chloride
- 3. Spray Polyurethane Foam Systems with unreacted MDI (two part systems)

Ø Statewide workshops and stakeholder engagement **Ø** Regulations being drafted







Priority Product Work Plan

- § Identify product categories for next 3 years
- § Provide market signals
- § Engage stakeholders, gather data
- § Identify potential Priority Products




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
Work Plan policy priorities

• Perfluorinated compounds

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

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
