Presentation abstract

Since leaving the EU at the end of 2020, the UK has been diverging from European Regulations, including REACH and CLP, as these regulations have continued to be regularly updated and the UK no longer automatically implements these changes.

These changes include "routine" updates, such as updates to the Candidate List, Restrictions List, new harmonized classifications, etc. In addition, the EU is marching on with its own agenda, including major revisions planned for REACH and CLP.

This presentation will highlight some of the key divergences, review the processes being put into place for updating and complying with UK regulations, and look at some of the future changes being planned in the EU.
