Presentation abstract

Third party reviews are activities undertaken by a person or body independent of a producer or manufacturer of a product or service. The activities may result in a certification against a single- or multi-attribute standard such as Cradle to Cradle Certified[®], U.S. EPA Safer Choice, or the Health Product Declaration[®] Open Standard, among others. Other types of activities conducted as part of a third party review include independent assessment of the safety or sustainability of a chemical, material, or product, such as a ChemFORWARD Safer or GreenBlue's CleanGredients evaluation. Increasingly, third party reviews are sought out to demonstrate to consumers or investors that a product, service, or organization is operating in a safe and/or sustainable manner. This presentation will provide an overview of different types of third party reviews, identify steps to help you select the best third party review to accomplish your organization's sustainability or environmental health-related goals, and recommend resources to help you navigate the labyrinth of third party reviews available in the marketplace.
