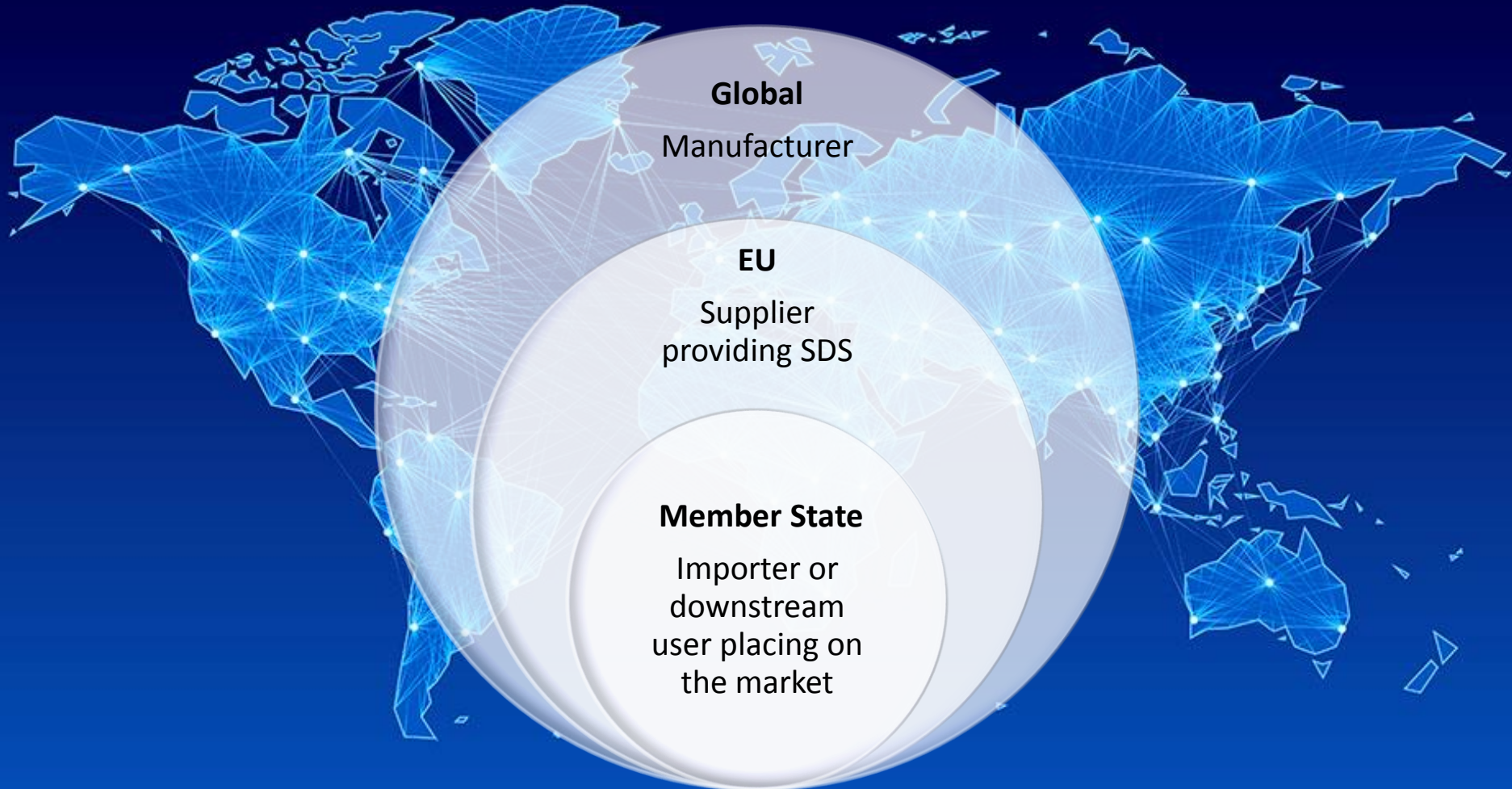

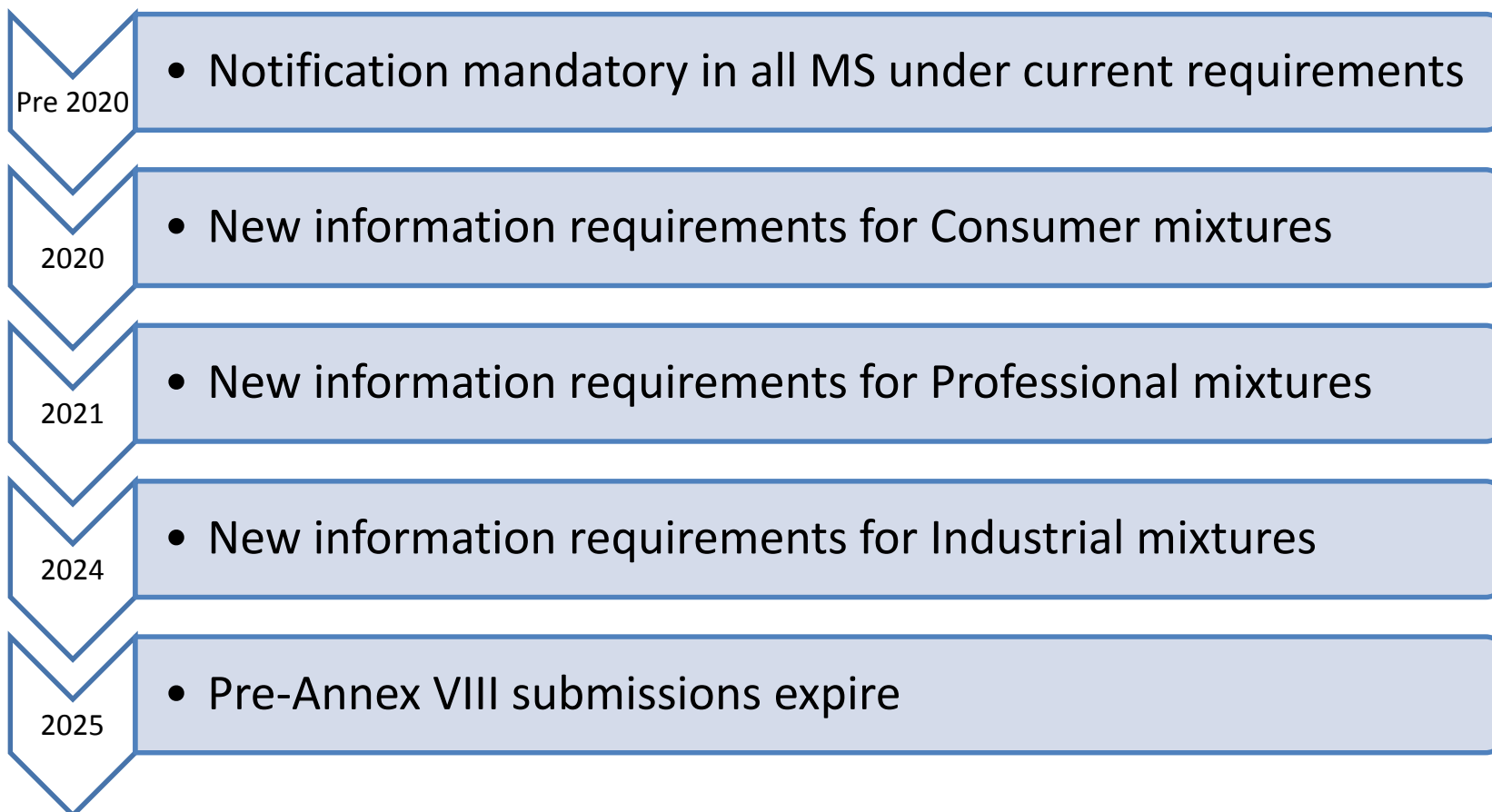

Unique Formula Identifier

UFI JY10-Y0JM-W006-8975



Danger

Highly flammable liquid and vapour
Toxic if swallowed, in contact with skin or if inhaled
Causes serious eye irritation
Causes damage to organs (central nervous system, optic nerve)

Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames and other ignition sources. No smoking
Take precautionary measures against static discharge
Wear eye protection, protective gloves, protective clothing
IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a doctor
IF ON SKIN (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower
IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing

Mixture in a mixture (MIM) update

Change to product that requires update and triggers new UFI

Company A

Uses Company A's UFI in own notification must submit new notification and generate new UFI

Company B

Uses Company B's mixture in theirs. Must submit new notification and generate new UFI

Company C

Uses Company B's mixture in theirs. Must submit new notification and generate new UFI
